

NSYSU COVID-19 Prevention Measures

Enforced Period	Starting from September 8, 2022 onwards
Venue	Measures
Classrooms and Teaching Areas	<div>1. In-person classes to be conducted:<div><div>(1) In classes: instructors are suggested to wear masks during lectures; transparent masked can be substituted if necessary. Students shall wear masks at all times, disinfect regularly, and no eating or drinking is allowed.</div><div>(2) All classrooms shall be ventilated and sanitized periodically; all used equipment shall be sanitized after each class.</div></div></div> <div>2. Persons under home quarantine and self-health management shall not come to campus and attend classes. International students under quarantine period (3 + 4 days) shall be under the “Reassurance Education Program” to ensure learning is not disrupted. Instructors shall provide alternative learning options, either asynchronous or synchronous classes, online learning platforms or options for missed classes. Students’ semester grades shall not be affected due to absence related to home quarantine or self-health management.</div> <div>3. Principles for PE (physical education), swimming, internship, and performing arts classes:<div><div>(1) PE classes: masks shall be worn, but can be temporarily removed during exercising, under the condition where in structor and students do not have respiratory-related symptoms, and social distancing is maintained.</div><div>(2) Swimming classes: check temperature and sanitize the equipment and facility; masks shall be worn at all times except when swimming and utilizing specific facility, such as shower room.</div><div>(3) Internships: divide into fixed groups during internship and experiments and avoid sharing the equipment; if shar- ing requires, thorough disinfection is required for the next user.</div><div>(4) Performing arts classes: masks shall be worn except during singing, dancing, and playing wind instruments; the duration for practice shall be adjusted when necessary</div></div></div> <div>4. Classroom sanitization and disinfection management:<div><div>(1) Keep the classrooms well-ventilated:<div><div>A. with air conditioner/central air conditioning system, the doors can be closed during the class with windows from across corners of the room remaining open for at least 15 cm.</div><div>B. without air-conditioner, it can be equipped with wall fans or stand fans.</div></div></div><div>(2) Increase frequency of cleaning and sanitization: On-campus air-conditioning systems shall be sanitized before new semester starts; classrooms and shuttle buses shall be periodically sanitized; the cleaning personnel shall be provided with comprehensive training, and be re- quire to report daily health conditions for the record.</div></div></div> <div>5. Field trips: masks shall be worn at all time; trips shall be planned with caution for the destinations and accommoda- tion; follow all relevant preventive measures announced by the government.</div>
All indoor venues	<div>Check temperature and wear masks at all times at such indoor venues as offices, library and meeting room, etc.</div>
Gymnasium and Sports/Fit-ness Facili- ties	<div>Masks can be temporarily removed when exercising, unless when individuals have respiratory-related symptoms and cannot maintain social distancing.</div>
Student Center	<div>Student Club activities shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related measures set by Student Life and Career Development Division (SLCDD) of the Office of Student Affairs:</div> <div>1. Off-campus activities, overnight activities, field trips, and large-scale public gathering events can be organized with the requirement to submit a proposal 7-day in advance to the Counseling and Health Service Division for approval and further have it recorded at SLCDD.</div> <div>2. Non-NSYSU members are NOT permitted to join club activities, except for instructors for club classes. Non-NSYSU in- structors shall have completed the 3rd vaccine shot for at least 14 days; for individuals who are neither vaccinated, nor are the 3rd vaccine shot for 14 days, the proof of the negative result of the COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours shall be provided.</div>
Campus Dorms	<div>1. The dormitory office shall take measures for the health-management, including enter control, checking temperature, periodical sanitization, and wearing mask.</div> <div>2. Public areas are disinfected twice daily, and liquid soap or soap bars are provided at all washbasins.</div> <div>3. Shower stalls are open and encouraged using alternate stalls.</div> <div>4. Strongly advised wearing a mask in areas outside dorm rooms.</div> <div>5. Each dorm building is provided with a thermometer and alcohol dispenser for students in need.</div> <div>6. Students with a travel history of entering and exiting Taiwan within 30-days of move-in shall provide a negative result of the COVID-19 test taken within 2 days of the move-in date.</div>
Restaurants, Stores, and shops	<div>1. Masks can be temporarily removed while dining.</div> <div>2. The restaurants shall periodically sanitize the surrounding; the employees shall wear masks and wash hands; the cus- tomer shall check temperature and sanitize the hands.</div>
Other Venues	<div>The Notice for NSYSU COVID-19 Prevention Measures and temperature monitors are required to set at each entrance of each building. It is required to check temperature and wear masks when you enter each building.</div>
On-Campus Activities	<div>1. Gatherings & activities, including meetings, on-campus workshops, student club performing-related, and faculty & staff club-related, shall implement measures such as checking temperature and and wearing masks at all times. No dining is allowed while activities are in progress. If dining is in need, designated dining areas shall be set up and peri- odically sanitized.</div> <div>2. All student activities, including department student association, department and department-alliance athletic teams, shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related preventive measures set by the Student Life and Career De- velopment Division of the Office of Student Affairs, with college offices acting as advising units.</div>
