NSYSU COVID-19 Prevention Measures

Starting from April 17, 2023 onwards

Classrooms and Teaching Areas

- 1. Classes to be conducted:
- (1) Masks can be removed during outdoor lecturing. While, it is suggested to wear masks in indoor classes, especially for those with respiratory symptoms.
- (2) For performing arts classes, music instruments and microphones (for theater arts) shall be used personally in principle, and the wind instruments shall be not shared.
- 2. Faculty and students under domiciliary care, home isolation and "self-quarantine with Covid-19 symptoms" shall not come to the campus for classes, during which the
 - "Reassurance Education Program" shall be implemented to ensure learning is not disrupted. Instructors shall provide alternative learning options, either asynchronous or synchronous classes, online learning platforms or options for missed classes. Students' academic evaluation shall not be affected, nor will their absence be recorded, due to the aforementioned reasons.
- 3. Well-ventilated and periodically-disinfected classroom:
- (1) For those with air conditioners/central air conditioning system: its air inlet/outlet and filter meshes, ceiling fans and other fans shall be cleaned and disinfected periodically.
- (2) For those without air-conditioner: the wall fans or stand fans can be installed
- (3) All equipment for class shall be sanitized before/after operation.

All Indoor Venues

It is suggested to wear mask, especially in the health center and clinic.

Campus Dorms

- 1. The dormitory office shall take measures for the health-management, including enter control and periodical sanitization.
- 2. Public areas shall be disinfected periodically, with the liquid soap or soap provided at all washbasins.
- 3. It is suggested to wear masks in the indoor area.
- 4. Each dorm building is installed with a thermometer and alcohol dispenser.

On-Campus Activities

- 1. The participants for the gatherings & activities (e.g. meetings, on-campus workshops, student club performing-related, and faculty & staff club-related) shall sanitize their hands at the entrances and inside the venues.
- 2. All club activities shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related preventive measures formulated by the Student Life and Career Development Division of the Office of Student Affairs.
- 3. All student activities, including department student association, department and department-alliance athletic teams, shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related preventive measures set by the Student Life and Career Development Division of the Office of Student Affairs, with college offices acting as advising units.
