

# NSYSU COVID-19 Prevention Measures

Venue	Measures
Classrooms and Teaching Areas	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In-person classes shall be conducted in accordance with the following, or distance learning mode shall be adopted instead:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fixed seating arrangement shall be practiced to keep contact tracing records; in cases where fixed seating is not possible, the instructor shall take a photo for future reference;</li> <li>In classes: instructors can temporarily remove masks during lectures when social distancing is maintained or partitions are in place; masks shall be worn at all times before and after lectures. Students shall wear masks at all times, disinfect regularly, and no eating or drinking is allowed.</li> <li>All classrooms shall be kept well ventilated and sanitized regularly, all equipment used during class shall be well sanitized afterward.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Persons under home quarantine and enhanced self-health management shall not come to campus and attend classes. International students under quarantine period (14 + 7 days) shall be under the "Reassurance Education Program" to ensure learning is not disrupted. Instructors shall provide alternative learning options, either asynchronous or synchronous classes, online learning platforms or options for missed classes. Students' semester grades shall not be affected due to absence related to COVID-19 (including vaccination).</li> <li>Principles for PE (physical education), swimming, internship, and performing arts classes:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>PE classes: masks shall be worn but can be temporarily removed during exercising, under the condition where instructor and students do not have respiratory-related symptoms, and social distancing is maintained. Masks shall be worn at all times when not exercising or after class. Contact tracing records shall be kept, and equipment sharing shall be avoided; in the case when sharing occurs, thorough disinfection is required for the next user.</li> <li>Swimming classes: keep contact tracing record, check temperature, sanitize equipment and facility, maintain ventilation, and monitor water quality; masks shall be worn at all times except for swimming and showering.</li> <li>Internships: follow the preventive measures of the Ministry of Education (MOE), use assigned equipment in divided groups to avoid sharing; when sharing occurs, thorough disinfection is required for the next user.</li> <li>Performing arts classes: masks shall be worn except during singing, dancing, and playing wind instruments. When the individual has respiratory-related symptoms and can NOT maintain social distancing, masks shall be worn. Instruments and mouthpieces shall not be shared.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Classroom sanitization and disinfection management:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Maintain well-ventilated conditions: in-person classes shall be arranged in classrooms with windows, and windows from across corners of the room shall remain open for at least 15 centimeters; when using central air condition system, make sure that the number of the air register and the air return vent grills are 2 to 1 in ratio to maintain circulation and interchanging air from outdoors.</li> <li>Increase frequency of cleaning and sanitization: disinfection shall proceed after an in-person class is dismissed; all academic units shall provide comprehensive training for cleaning personnel, who shall report daily health conditions for the record.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Field trips: masks shall be worn at all times and keep contact-tracing records; trips shall plan with caution on the destinations and accommodation and follow all relevant preventive measures announced by the government.</li> </ol>
Offices	Keep social distancing and wear masks at all times.
Meeting Rooms	Wear masks at all times, and no dining is allowed while meeting is in progress.
Library	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reading areas from the 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> floors are open and designated seating shall be followed.</li> <li>Wear masks at all times and keep social distancing.</li> </ol>
Gymnasium and Sports/Fitness Facilities	Masks shall be worn at all times for indoor and outdoor facilities. Check temperature, keep contact-tracing records, maintain social distancing, and no eating/drinking allowed (except for drinking water). Masks can be temporarily removed when exercising. Masks shall be worn when individuals have respiratory-related symptoms and cannot maintain social distancing.
Student Center	<p>Student Club activities shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related measures set by the Office of Student Affairs:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Off-campus activities, overnight activities, field trips, and large-scale public gathering events can be organized with the requirement to submit a proposal 7-days in advance to the Physical &amp; Health Division for approval and record-keeping.</li> <li>Non-NSYSU members are NOT permitted to join club activities except for instructors for club classes. Non-NSYSU instructors shall have completed the third vaccine shot for at least 14 days; for individuals who are not vaccinated or the third vaccine shot has not passed 14 days, proof of the negative result of the COVID-19 test taken within three days shall be provided.</li> </ol>
Campus Dorms	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Public areas are disinfected twice daily, and liquid soap or soap bars are provided at all washbasins.</li> <li>Shower stalls are open and encouraged using alternate stalls.</li> <li>Strongly advised wearing a mask in areas outside dorm rooms.</li> <li>Each dorm building is provided with a thermometer and alcohol dispenser for students in need.</li> <li>Students with a travel history of entering and exiting Taiwan within 30-days of move-in shall provide a negative result of the COVID-19 test taken within three days of the move-in date.</li> </ol>
Sun Yat-sen Hall	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For audiences: assigned seating, keep contact tracing records, temperature checks, and wear masks at all times.</li> <li>For performing groups: wear masks at all times and follow all preventive measures.</li> </ol>
Outdoor Public Areas	When entering campus, leave a contact tracing record, check for temperature, and wear masks at all times.

<b>Restaurants, Stores, and s h o p s</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Preventive measures for the food &amp; beverage industry set by the Ministry of Health and Welfare shall be followed to keep records of employees' health conditions, preventive measures, and facility sanitation. <b>In-door dining is open, and preventive guidelines shall be strictly implemented: keep contact tracing records, check the temperature, and disinfect regularly. Masks can be temporarily removed while dining.</b></li> <li>2. All shops shall adjust operation hours according to the latest preventive measure regulation.</li> </ol>
<b>Other Venues</b>	<p>Each building shall maintain one single entrance. Entering buildings requires checking temperature, wearing masks and presenting contact tracing records (NSYSU members shall present IDs, and non-NSYSU members shall present contact tracing text records)</p>
<b>On-Campus Activities</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Gatherings &amp; activities, including meetings, on-campus workshops, student club performing-related, and faculty &amp; staff club-related, can be held without limiting the maximum number of persons. Activities shall implement measures such as keeping contact tracing records, checking temperature, and wearing masks at all times. <b>No dining is allowed while activities are in progress.</b> If dining is required, designated dining areas shall be set up to avoid eating while walking. Preventive measures for the food &amp; beverage industry set by the Ministry of Health and Welfare shall be followed.</li> <li>2. All student activities, including department student association, department and department-alliance athletic teams, shall be organized in accordance with COVID-19 related preventive measures set by the Office of Student Affairs, with college offices acting as advising units.</li> <li>3. Art festival performance management: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Implement contact-information-based measures and mask mandates.</li> <li>(2) Temperature checks and disinfection at the entrance; in cases where an individual has a body temperature above 37.5 Celsius or is coughing continuously, staff will assist in leaving the venue.</li> <li>(3) Audiences shall be assigned designated seats for the entirety of the performance.</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. <b>The "Co-tea time" gathering for faculty and staff is temporarily suspended.</b></li> </ol>
